Report of the events during last 5 years

Department of Botany

1. A one-day seminar on "Medicinal Plants Available in our Localities in Curing Diseases" was organized by the Department of Botany, Bangabasi Morning College, on 22nd March 2018 at the smart classroom of the college premise. The event was chaired by Prof. Shipra Halder, Teacher-In-Charge, Bangabasi Morning College, and attended by teachers from different departments. Eminent scientist and teacher Dr. Debabrata Maity from the Department of Botany, University of Calcutta delivered his enlightening lecture about the different medicinal plants found in our locality and their uses. All students from Botany department and many students from other Bioscience departments participated in the event.




बंगवासी मॉर्निंग कॉलेज में मना हिंदी दिवस

Mughal Mansabdari System





Department of Physics

20. A two-day science fair was organised by the Department of Physics on 17th and 18th of December 2022. The fair has been organized with an aim to attract and to motivate new generation students in the basic science and technology. The enthusiasm was more than expected with 264 participants, around 30% of them are school children. The comment box was flooded with enthusiastic comments and suggestions. Several physics experiments (altogether 18) such as Lenz's law, dispersion of light, magnetic phenomena, collective oscillation etc. have been demonstrated to elucidate the physical laws to the common people, particularly younger generation. A research based collaborative (Department of Physics & Chemistry) experiment on dye (common water pollutant) degradation by semiconductor nanoparticles using photocatalysis in sunlight (abundant and free) has also been demonstrated. 34 students and 4 faculty members of the department of physics have participated as volunteers and demonstrators. Several ex-students of the department have also participated in the event. The encouragement and financial support from the college authority have to be mentioned. Inspired by the event and using the infrastructure and resource persons of the department, a renowned higher secondary school in Calcutta (Shri Shikshayatan school) have organized a science exhibition on 29th April, 2023.
