
Program Report

Polycystic Ovariansyndrome is a condition in which the ovaries produce an abnormal amount of androgens ,male sex hormones that are usually present in women amounts. The name Polycystic ovary syndrome describes the numerous small cysts (fluid-filled sacs) that form in the ovaries. However, some women without the disorder do not have cysts, while some women without the disorder develop cysts. Dr. Debashish Ghatak, Gynaecologist and Obstetrician, MR Bangur hospital, Tollygunge, Kolkata , was invited as the guest speaker . He highlightedsome crucial points regarding this issue since it created heap of prejudice ,discriminations, marginalization and social obstacles amongst the young girls and their families.

PCOS is the single most heterogenous and multisystem endocrine abnormality of women of reproductive age group and most common cause of secondary amenorrhoea. It was discovered by Stein and Leventhal in 1935. Worldwide 6-10% but more common in infertility 20%, becoming more common in adolescent girls often developing soon puberty.
